***ABOUT THE PROGRAM:***

The private practice of medicine is experiencing fundamental change at a dizzying pace, in large part because decreased reimbursement rates, increased expenses, and extensive governmental regulation are making it more difficult than ever for practices to maintain their historical levels of profitability. While this change will affect practices of all sizes, the most dramatic effect may, in fact, be on smaller practices. We are also seeing large hospital systems gobbling up solo practitioners and physicians in small group practices, and transforming them into hospital employees. As if all of this market-driven craziness wasn't enough, the Federal government earlier this year passed the most extensive and complicated health care reform legislation in history.

This challenging environment is forcing physicians to begin to explore new business relationships. As a result, medical group administrators need to help their physicians better understand the various healthcare delivery models that are just coming into place now, such as accountable care organizations, patient-centered medical homes, co-management arrangements with hospitals, and large group consolidations (e.g., mega-groups"); which structure is best for them; and what they should be doing right now to position themselves for the future.

This presentation will explore the current challenges which group practices face as a result of these fundamental changes in the world of private practice. The speaker, Joel M.
