

Led by Attorney Robert A. Spolzino, Abrams Fensterman has taken action on behalf of six residents, identifying significant racial disparities in the town's election outcomes. According to Spolzino, the existing system has consistently failed to elect African American or Hispanic candidates to town office, despite these groups making up a substantial portion of the population.
