[Westfair Business Journal](#) reported on the win stating "A Westchester Supreme Court judge has dismissed a 2017 lawsuit where two Yonkers landlords claimed that the fire department was using inspection fees for work other than a fire and building safety inspection program."

Two landlords challenged the city, claiming inspection fees were improperly used for "work other than a fire and building safety inspection program." However, Judge Giacomo ruled that the landlords "only speculate" about the fees' use and "failed to prove beyond a reasonable doubt that there were missed inspections," resulting in a victory for the city.
